The Metropolitan Kansas City Region of the Jane Austen Society of North America (JASNA) will be displaying an original quilt incorporating the 18th century pelisse fabric reproduced for Jane Austen's House Museum at

Harper's Fabric & Quilt Co. the first week of October.

This uniquely designed quilt was inspired by the one Jane, Cassandra and Mrs. Austen pieced together while living at Chawton Cottage.

Like the quilt fashioned by the Austen women, the result is impressive. "I love the colors and the careful placement of them to reflect Jane's quilt," remarked Collections Volunteer Sue Dell who helped restore the original coverlet.

The designs are from the 1920s to the 1940s era and include Grandmother's Flower Garden, Dresden Plate, Parasol Ladies, Hummingbird blocks, among other classic designs. Many are hand appliquéd, hand embroidered or cross-stitched. The sizes range from 60-85 inches in width and 70-99 inches in length. Borders and bindings are variable with unique designs incorporated in each of them. The condition levels range from very nice to excellent.
